Authors are advised to follow the Chicago Manual of Style (17<sup>th</sup> Edition) in preparing a manuscript. All papers submitted will go through preliminary checks by the editors to confirm appropriateness for the journal. Thereafter, the manuscript will be peer reviewed anonymously.

Papers accepted will be subjected to further editing, which are not necessarily substantive, but stylistic, in order to conform to the standard of the journal.
